

How to search for PKVs

Facebook is one of the quickest ways to approach, cast vision and identify PKVs (Potential Key Volunteer) in a target location.

Here is a simple process to follow:

| 1 | Pray | Ask God to reveal those people who have a passion for Him and building His Kingdom. |
| 2 | Search | <p>Here are some searching options:</p> <p>In the Search Bar write a sentence that will help you to identify Christians. It should contain few keywords describing the name of your target location, something that Christians usually like, a certain category of people. For instance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● “Student in Szczecin who likes Hillsong”● “People who live in Oradea and like Bible”● “People in Bucuresti who like...”<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ “Jesus Christ” “God” “Christianity”○ “Jesus Daily” “The Passion of Christ”○ “Tim Keller” “John Piper”○ “Chris Tomlin” “Bethel Music” “Hillsong United”○ “Lecrae” “Trip Lee” “Andy Mineo” <p>As you identify some Christians, look on their profile and see if they go to an event or like other pages, are part of some Christian groups, etc. It is another way to identify new people who like the same things.</p> |
| 3 | Send them a friend request | Send them a friend request. This way your message will not go into their filtered messages. |
| 4 | Write them a short message of casting vision | <p>Write them a short message of casting vision. You may write:</p> <p><i>Hi Ania,</i></p> <p><i>My name is Cristina and I partner with Ruch Akademicki Pod Prąd (RAPP), a Christian organization in Poland that seeks to encourage youth to live out an authentic Christian life. I am here in Szczecin, Poland until the end of first</i></p> |

week of April and am looking to connect with students who are interested in growing in their faith during university, and helping others know who Jesus is and why that matters for their lives.

*Would you be interested in this, or do you know anyone who would be?
Thanks for your time!*

Or

“Hello, Artur! My name is Cam and I work for an international Christian student organization called “Alege Viata” in Romania. We are here for a month, searching for university students who have a heart for God and have a passion to tell their classmates about Him. Do you think you have this passion? Do you know anyone who does? I would like to talk with you more about this, in case you are interested. Thank you!”

5 Send the message a second time

After they accepted your friend request, send the message again if they did not respond/view the message. (In order to be sure that the person will receive a notification. Some privacy settings automatically send all messages to the filtered inbox)

6 Create an excel sheet to keep track of the process

Create an excel sheet that will help you to record the process of work. It may contain 4 columns:

- Name
- Contacted by (in case you search as a team)
- Friended
- Response

You may use different colors to further categorize the contact as you work with them:

- green: interested, answered, appointment set up;
- yellow: didn't answer yet;
- red: not interested, live somewhere else, etc.
