“KEY VOLUNTEER CHALLENGE BLURB”

(This challenge is suggested to be given to a Potential Key Volunteer with whom you have already built initial relationship or friendship with to avoid “shock syndrome” . You may use “soularium” type of questions as initial “getting-to-know” step (see attached page for more info about soularium) Be sensitive to God’s leading and depend on Him. Remember: “Success in finding KVs is simply taking the initiative to look for KVs in the power of the Holy Spirit and leaving the results to God!)

YOU: How would you describe the world today? [PKV: (family breakdown, immorality, corruption, injustice, etc.)]

YOU: What do you think are the reasons why we face such problems? [allow response]

YOU: But what could be the main reason why we face such problems? What is the heart of the problem? [allow response, leading to: the heart of the problem is the problem of the heart – sin in the heart of man]

YOU: Since meaningful transformation can only come from changed hearts, what or who do you think can bring about such “heart change”? [allow response, leading to: Jesus Christ]

YOU: Let us say that the sinful heart of man is a disease for which you know the cure. What will you do? [PKV: (share it to others)]

The reason why I wanted to get together with you is to share with you the great need for Christ in the world today, how God is using Campus Crusade for Christ to help meet that need, and how you can help.

WHO WE ARE:

I have been involved with Campus Crusade for Christ since my ____ year in college. This movement is present in more or less 200 countries all over the world. As a movement of change, we believe that a single chain of change begins in the heart. A heart that has been changed by Jesus Christ is destined to create an impact in society.

We embody the verses found in **Matthew 28:18–20** which is known as The Great Commission. It says: “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

Our BATTLE CRY: COME HELP CHANGE THE WORLD!

Why begin movements of change in "CAMPUSES"? Why "COLLEGE STUDENTS"?

College students are the ones who will eventually take on vital roles in society as lawmakers, businessmen, influencers in the academe, etc. – making it one of the most strategic areas of our society for change. As it has been said: Students today ... Leaders tomorrow!

WHAT WE DO:

I. WIN

Evangelism – We help initiate "heart change" by telling others about Christ and how they can receive Him as their personal Lord and Savior. We share Christ through the "Four Spiritual Laws Booklet" (**show 4SL booklet**) and we do this both one-on-one and with groups.

II. BUILD

Follow-up & Discipleship – Every new believer gets the opportunity to be followed up – to learn to study God's word, pray and tell others about Christ. We do follow-up through the use of the "Beginning Your New Life Series" booklets (**show follow-up booklets**) and we also do this both one-on-one and with groups. Here are some of the students I meet in growth groups (**show pictures and share some details**). What I desire to see as I meet these students is for them to grow in a way that they will become mature and trained enough to spiritually multiply in the lives of many others. Let me read II Timothy 2:2 with you. (**share and illustrate the principle of spiritual multiplication by reading II Timothy 2:2, showing your spider chart or a diagram of spiritual multiplication**).

As I actively get involved in spiritual multiplication, nothing amazes me more than seeing miracles of changed lives unfolding right before my eyes!

Training – We conduct trainings on the different aspects of growth like how to tell others about Christ, how to help others grow in their relationship with God as well as trainings on leadership, self-management and others. We believe that training is more than just passing information. Training means life change!

III. SEND

Sending – Jesus' final command as written in the Great Commission is to GO. It is our desire to send every believer whom we have "won and built" in Christ to also do the same to others in his area of influence and beyond. And the cycle continues!

We exist to see people changed and our society transformed through Jesus Christ. I have shared with you the great need for Christ in the world today, and what we are doing in Campus Crusade for Christ to help meet that need.
