1. **Evangelistic:** www.EveryStudent.com - addresses topics that students care about; every page helps them understand who God is, or what it might be like to know God. There is an opportunity to send an email question and receive a personal reply. The site is currently in 34 languages. 2. **Doing Follow-up:** www.StartingwithGod.com - a site to help a new believer grow in their relationship with God. Ideally, this site would be in your language, and new believers from EveryStudent.com would be directed to it. Also useful in discipling any Christian.
3. **Ministry Net Conference:** In 2009, 150 ministry leaders and innovators from around the globe came together at MInistryNet conference to learn and advance effective use of the virtual. 4. **Launching Movements:** www.2Tim22.com. This site is designed to recruit, challenge and connect potential students to launch and grow movements in Eastern Europe and Russia. It provides basic training in how to start from a few students praying through win build send to see a movement. It also gives students an opportunity to make a commitment to trust God for a movement by putting their city on the google map as well as connect with other like hearted students via facebook login and actual message boards and chat rooms on the site itself.
5. **TOM: Together on Mission** – this is a Facebook application that anyone in the world can download and use to connect to a group of missional people to share stories and resources, and be empowered to be on mission with Jesus. All information is collected through Facebook, yet stored on secure private servers that only chosen users can access or appropriately share information. It is a free download for every student in the world on every campus, everywhere. Any campus may freely set itself up to use and administrate the tool in about 10 minutes.
