<p>The starting point of this stage is: When you currently have no Key Volunteers in a particular location (university/city).</p>	<p>-Does the PKV share our mission, vision & values? -Is the PKV willing to take ownership of the mission & vision and be used in Win, Build, Send areas?</p>	<p>1-2 KVs who are: -Formulating their personal vision, -Praying consistently for their classmates, -Sharing the gospel with students regularly, -Beginning to cast vision to other believers.</p>	<p>1-Network with any possible contacts to find Potential Key Volunteers; Cast vision to PKVs, pastors, & with anyone else who will listen 2-Go through the KV Challenge with PKVs 3-Take PKVs sharing on campus (provide simple 'mini-training' on sharing the gospel) 4-Give the PKVs a faith challenge (for example: 30 day faith challenges) 5-Go through the KV Agreement with PKVs</p>	<p>This campus is ready to move to the next stage when you have: At least 1-2 committed KVs in one location (university/city).</p>
<p>Stage 2 Developing & Equipping KVs to LAUNCH a Movement</p>	<p>Key Question (what do we need to find out)</p>	<p>Goals for Stage 2</p>	<p>Broad stroke Coach Action Points</p>	<p>Needed to move to next stage</p>
<p>In this stage you are starting with: 1-2 committed KVs (who you are beginning to develop as leaders with 'movement-planting' DNA).</p>	<p>-Are they passing on what they are learning to others? -Are they continuing to take faith steps to grow? -Are they beginning to multiply themselves, cast vision to others, are they gathering and mobilizing others (even if it's just 1-2 others)?</p>	<p>5-6 KVs who are: -Mobilizing others for prayer & evangelism, -Broadly casting vision while gathering & training others to building a movement together, -Beginning to disciple others to multiply, -Moving toward developing a team.</p>	<p>1-Equip them with basic ministry skills for gathering and launching (sharing the gospel, follow up, casting vision, etc), 2-Provide for an environment for spiritual growth (personal walk with God). 3-Begin developing the KVs as leaders, 4-Start including some vision for launching in other areas (in universities and in other cities)</p>	<p>This campus is ready to move to the next stage when you have: 5-6 KVs who are meeting regularly to pray, share the gospel and are beginning to form an identity as a team that will trust God to build a movement.</p>

<p><i>The starting point of this stage is:</i> When you have an aligned team of 5-6 KVs.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Are the team members growing in the Lord as well as growing in ministry, vision & skills? -Do they have a basic movement plan that they are following? (Essential Path) -Are they spiritually multiplying? Are new leaders being developed? -Is the movement growing? -Are they beginning to talk about getting the gospel to new places? 	<p>A student-led movement with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -New students being won to Christ, -Multiple generations of disciples, -Multiplication of leaders, -Self-sustaining movement. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1-Continue coaching movement leaders to build movements, 2-Provide timely resources and helpful insights & pray with them & for them, 3-Provide resource development training (funds, manpower, materials, etc). 	<p><i>This campus is ready to move to the next stage when you have:</i></p> <p>10 or more students who share our vision & who are trusting God together in sharing the gospel on campus, building into multiplying disciples, equipping & mobilizing others to do the same & who are praying about launching new movements in new locations.</p>

<p><i>The starting point of this stage is:</i> The KV team targets new areas to launch new movements in other locations.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Are they expanding their influence without forsaking the development of the local movement? Are they able to do both well? -Are they successfully coaching in other locations? Are the new locations where they are coaching expanding? 	<p>-Multiplying Movements: KV teams begin to launch new KV teams in new locations.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1-Continue coaching original movement leaders to launch new movements 2-Keep resourcing as needed 3-Help them develop a plan and take steps for launching in new locations. 4-Train leaders in how to coach new KV teams (refer the KV teams to Stage 1 of this guide for direction) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Multiplying movements/expanding influence across a broad scope -Graduates have a personal vision and commitment to seeing the world reached for Christ.
